Anglican School of Ministry will conduct two courses during the week prior to the 2012 Winter Conference in Houston, TX:

Jan 6-8 FOU 007 Intensive Introduction to Anglicanism (18 continuing education hours)

FOU 007 is designed to assist candidates to prepare for the distinctively Anglican issues on their ordination exams, especially those who come from a non-Anglican tradition. The course is also useful for anyone who wants a refresher in the treasures of our Anglican faith. In addition, students will experience Anglican worship through a variety of services.

Jan 9-10 MIN 101 Liturgics Workshop (1 semester hour),

MIN 101 is a practical, hands-on course in conducting the worship of the church in the Book of Common Prayer tradition. It includes an examination of the Daily Offices, Litany, Holy Matrimony, and Holy Communion services. Experienced pastors will share their insights on the challenges and opportunities of leading the liturgies

Course Costs

FOU 007 Intensive Introduction to Anglicanism: \$300.00

MIN 101 Liturgics Workshop: \$150.00

Neither course is available for auditing. Students who take both courses will receive a \$25.00 discount. Students are responsible for their own room, board, and transportation.
